Good morning,

My name is Jacob Johnson, and I am the Registrar at Centre College.

Over the next few weeks, you will be receiving a series of emails from my office to guide you through the advising and registration process.

### **Things to be on the lookout for:**

- **First-Year Student Onboarding Video**
  - There is a comprehensive video that will guide you through the basics of registration, course selection, and how to navigate your degree requirements. - **Pre-Matriculation Microsoft Form Link**
  - Here is a link to submit any pre-matriculation coursework that you would like us to evaluate. <https://forms.cloud.microsoft/r/RTtu2aBCHB>
  - Pre-matriculation coursework includes any dual credit coursework, advanced placement exams, and/or international baccalaureate exams. Evaluations will be shared just before the start of the Fall term to allow for any needed schedule changes.
- **Advising / Registration Clearance**
  - All incoming students are expected to meet with their summer academic adviser virtually before registration week. Once you have met with your summer adviser, they will clear you for registration. Registration clearance is required before you can register for classes in CentreNet on your own. **If you have not met with your summer academic adviser before registration week, you will not be able to register for classes until your adviser has cleared you for registration.**

### **Action Items:**

- Watch the video linked above to learn more about advising and Centre's resources. The video will cover how to access a variety of resources that will guide you through course selection.
- Students should begin familiarizing themselves with the general education requirements that each student is required to complete as part of their graduation requirements and carefully read over all materials that are discussed through the video.
- Meet with your summer academic adviser and receive registration clearance

**Once you have watched the video, reviewed the associated resources, and receive registration clearance, you will be ready to register yourself for your fall term courses online on CentreNet. We will send you two more messages next week with detailed information about how to register online and various tips about course selection.**

**First-year students will be asked to register for fall classes online during the week of July 6-10. Watch for more detailed information in the next two weeks!**
